- 1. After the Room Service representative has checked the items a Consignor wishes to sell, a fair price will be determined for the consignment. Items are reviewed and accepted Monday through Friday. The Consignor's name will be kept confidential.**
2. Items must be clean and in good repair. If damage is discovered after the Consignor has left, the defective item will be held for 7 days for the Consignor to pick up if wanted. After 7 days, the defective item will be donated. It is the Consignor's responsibility to check with Room Service to determine if any items were not accepted.
- 3. Room Service will endeavor to sell a consignment at the initial price for thirty days. After this time, the sales price may be reduced 10%; additional 10% reductions are authorized after each subsequent 30 day period. Consignments that remain unsold after 120 days will be considered expired, marked half or more off, and are immediately subject to donation. It is the Consignor's responsibility to monitor their consignments and pick up any wanted items before the expiration date.**
4. Room Service will make every effort in handling with care any and all consignments; however, all risks of fire, theft, or any damage to the property delivered under this agreement shall be retained by the Consignor, and the Consignor shall keep such property fully insured at the expense of the Consignor and for the benefit of and in the name of the Consignor.
- 5. Payment will be dispersed by Room Service on the 15th of the month following the month in which an item is sold. Only checks outside the Lexington area will be mailed. Checks that are not picked up within 6 months from date of issue will be considered void and store credit will be issued to the Consignor for the same amount.**
6. For services and facilities furnished in connection with the sale of property received under this agreement, the Consignor/Consignee split will be as follows:
 - A. For all items that sell for more than \$50.00, the Consignee shall be entitled to 40% of the sales price, and the remaining 60% of the proceeds shall be the property of the Consignor.
 - B. For all items that sell for \$50.00 or less, the Consignee shall be entitled to 50% of the sales price and the remaining 50% of the proceeds shall be the property of the Consignor.
